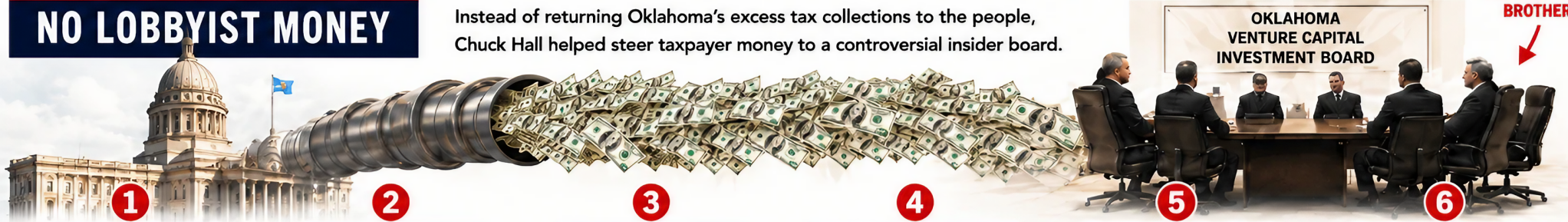

The Senate President Pro Temp appoints Chuck Hall’s brother, Zack Hall, to the board as one of five members.
