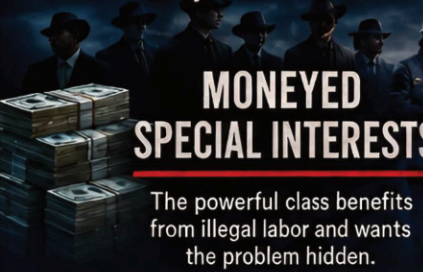


CHUCK HALL'S SMOKE & MIRRORS GAME
